

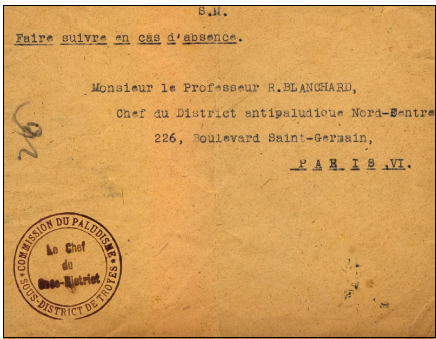

*Size:* 37 mm  
*Usage:* *Earliest Reported:* September 13, 1916

*Notes:* part of the International Health Commission (1913-1916) that conducted campaigns against malaria, yellow fever, and hookworm in areas throughout Europe, Latin America and the Caribbean including Italy, France, Venezuela, Mexico, and Puerto Rico

*Handstamp:* HS-1  
*Cancel:* Paris: September 13, 1916  
*Notes:* time slug in cds inverted; addressed to Dr. Raphaël Blanchard, chief of the Malaria Commission for the Central District, Paris; he became interested in parasitology in 1896 and founded the journal *Archives de parasitologie* in 1898
