

SIR RONALD ROSS's work on the transmission of malaria, completed in 1897, provided the foundation for tropical medicine in the 20th century – and, as a result, Ross became the first British scientist to receive the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine. For centuries, malaria was endemic in low-lying parts of Europe, but by the late 19th century it was widely seen as a characteristically tropical disease. Several researchers working in European colonies in Africa and Asia had identified a microscopic parasite – now known as *Plasmodium falciparum* – as the organism responsible for malaria. But its life cycle was notoriously complex, depending upon insect vectors and local environmental factors. Ross, a young doctor in the Indian Medical Service, spent several years dissecting the relationship between *Plasmodium* and the *Anopheles* mosquito. On 20 August 1897 – ‘Mosquito Day’ in Ross’s diary – he completed his study. Ross’s theory of malaria transmission was quickly adopted, and in 1902 he received only the second Nobel Prize given out in his field. Ross’s pioneering multidisciplinary approach provided a highly influential model for later research on tropical diseases, and it has stimulated a series of attempts to control and eradicate malaria in many parts of the world.
