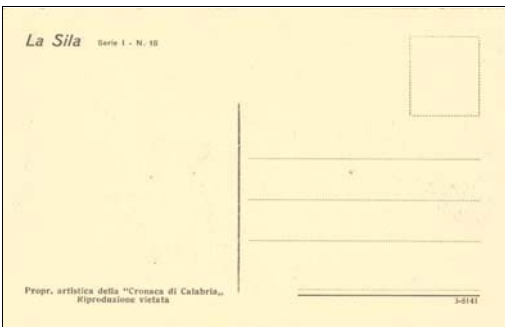

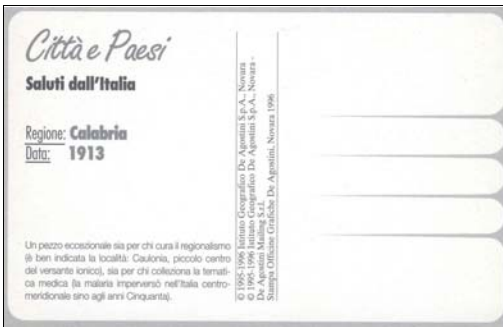

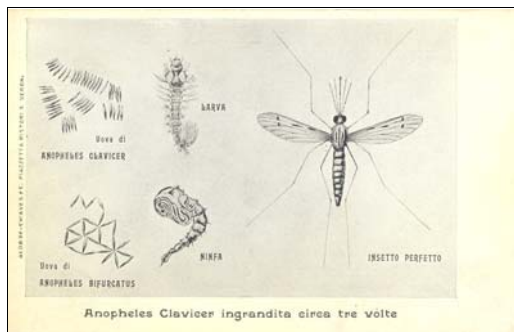


Image: comparative development of 2 Anopheles species

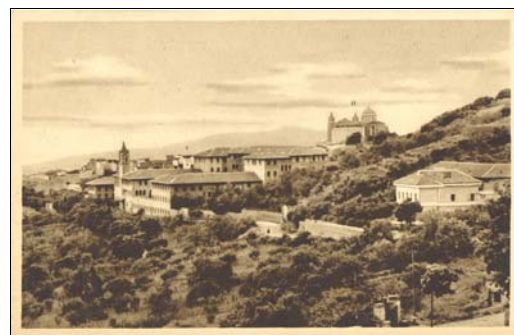
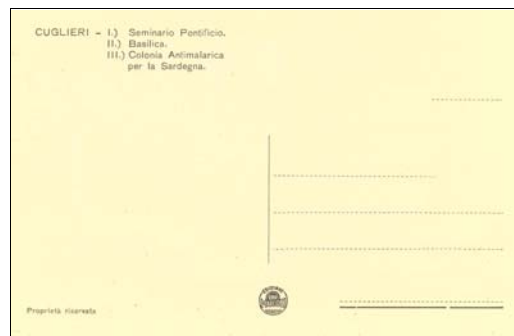


Image: Cuglieri view with numerals marking 3 sites [see *Text*]

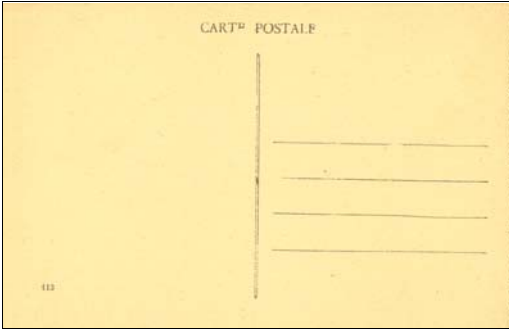
