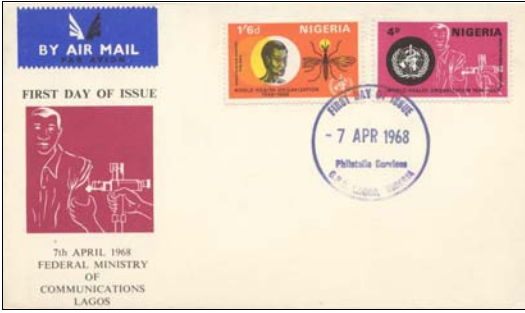

The two special postage stamps affixed on the First Day Cover mark the 20th Anniversary of the World Health Organisation (WHO) and were released on the 7th of April, 1968 - World Health Day.

Designed by Mr. Julius Owe of the Graphic Arts Dept. of the Federal Ministry of Information, the stamps have been printed by Colony Press at the Nigerian Security Printing and Minting Co. Ltd., Lagos.

Supplies of these special covers can be obtained through the Crown Agents, Philatelic Bureau, 26, Abchurch Lane, St. Dunstons, London, E.C. 4, England, and all countries from the Royal Philatelic, G.P.O. Offices, Lagos, on application accompanied by appropriate remittance to cover the cost of stamps plus postage by registered air mail.

The cost of each cover is 5.00 inclusive of the face value of the two stamps.

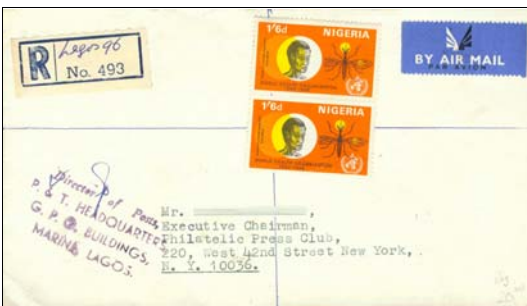
