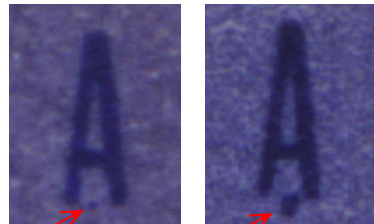

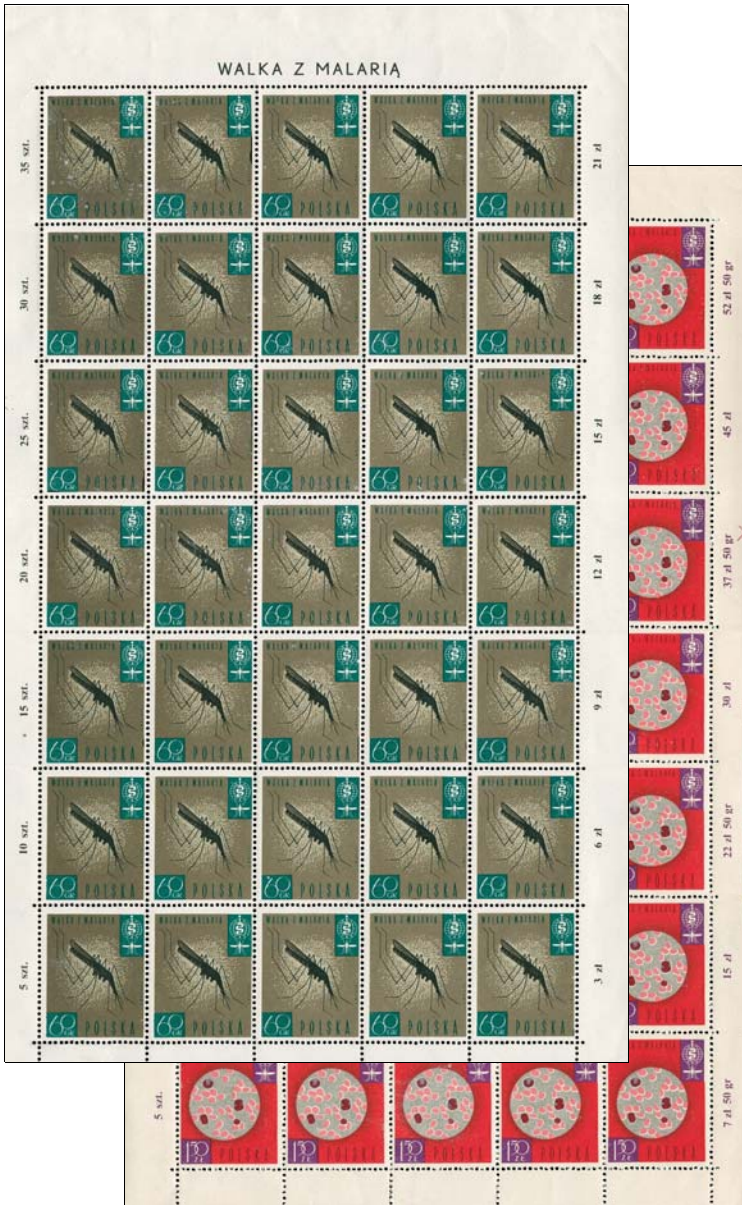

Światowa Organizacja Zdrowia od lat prowadzi walkę we wszystkich częściach świata z malarją, która jeszcze teraz powoduje więcej niż milion śmiertelnych przypadków rocznie.

Poczta Polska, łącząc się w kampanii międzynarodowej zwalczania malarii, wprowadza w dniu 1 października 1962 r. do obiegu 3 znaczki i 1 blokcek z umieszczonym na nich emblematem walki z malarją.

Znaczek wartości 60 gr przedstawia najniebezpieczniejszego nosiciela zarazków malarii.

Na znaczku, wartości 1,50 zł, przedstawiono kroplę krwi ze znajdującymi się w niej zarazkami malarii.

back and front

Znaczek, wartości 2,50 zł, przedstawia kwiat drzewa chinowego, z którego kory uzyskuje się chininę będącą, od odkrycia w 1820 r., pierwszym środkiem zwalczania malarii. Na blokczku, wartości 3- zł, przedstawiono moskit.

Część nakładu znaczków została przeznaczona jako wkład Polski do międzynarodowego funduszu zwalczania malarii.



For years past the World Health Organisation has been waging a war in all parts of the world against malaria which is still causing more than one million deaths annually.

The Polish Post Office has joined in the international campaign of malaria eradication and will issue on October 1, 1962, 3 stamps and 1 souvenir sheet, which have in their designs the emblem of malaria eradication.

The 60 gr stamp represents anopheline mosquito, the most dangerous carrier of the malaria parasites.

The 1.50 zł stamp represents bacteria of malaria in a drop of blood.

The 2.50 zł stamp represents a flower of the quinine tree which, discovered in 1820, was the first medicine used against malaria.

The design of the 3 zł souvenir represents the anopheline mosquito.

A part of the issue is devoted to the international fund of malaria eradication.



Die Weltgesundheitsorganisation führt seit Jahren in allen Weltteilen den Kampf gegen Malaria, die noch jetzt jährlich über eine Million Todesfälle verursacht.

Die Polnische Post nimmt an der internationalen Kampagne der Malariaabkämpfung teil und gibt am 1. October 1962 3 Briefmarken und 1 Block mit dem Emblem des Kampfes gegen Malaria heraus.

Die Briefmarke zu 60 Gr. stellt den gefährlichsten Träger der Malariaabazillen dar.

Auf der 1,50 Zł.— Briefmarke sehen wir ein Blutkörperchen mit Malariaabazillen.

Die 2,50 Zł Briefmarke, stellt die Blume des Chinabaumes dar, aus dessen Rinde Chinin gewonnen wird, das seit seiner Entdeckung im Jahre 1820 das erste Mittel der Malariaabkämpfung ist.



Auf dem Block im Wert von 3-— Zł sehen wir die Stechmücke. Ein Teil der Briefmarkenaufgabe wurde als Polens Anteil am internationalen Fonds für die Malariaabkämpfung vorgesehen.
