

Dear Sirs,

THIOTEPA  
(tris (1-aziridinyl) phosphine sulphide)

As a matter of urgency I am writing to request a sample quantity of 5 grammes of "Thiotepa". The compound is of value for causing sexual sterility in insects. I have been particularly interested in its use by this means for mosquito control (see White: Nature 210, 1372, 1966 and J. Med. Ent., 1: 374, 1970).

The opportunity has just arisen here of suppressing a wild population of Culex fatigans mosquitoes by the technique of releasing sterilized males. It is to complete this experiment that I wish to obtain a supplementary quantity of thiotepa. I should like to have it for use in early July and hope that you can supply by air-mail.
